

Rose Paving Donates \$10,000 to Olympia Fields Police Department

Drunk-driving occurrences have risen in the village and usage of these cameras will help curtail such incidences," says Alan Rose, CEO. "Furthermore, I hope this contribution will raise awareness for public safety while also encouraging other charitable outreach programs to donate to their local law enforcement agencies."
